STUDENT BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES**

Parents, please read this together with your student and sign below.

Students will be responsible for learning self-control, self-direction, responsibility and cooperation. Compass Prep staff will work with the students and parents to help develop these characteristics.

General rules of conduct are as follows:

1. Students are to be respectful to teachers by listening, following directions, and displaying a positive attitude. "Talking back" to an adult is not permitted.
2. Students are to be respectful to other students by listening when another student is sharing in class, being encouraging to others and keeping negative comments to themselves. Teasing of other students and/or calling names are not acceptable behavior and will not be tolerated.
3. Students are to be respectful of the rights and property of others.
4. Students are expected to work to the best of their ability and complete all work assignments unless the teacher and/or parent has instructed otherwise.
5. Students will not be allowed to disrupt the learning environment for other students. Repeated violations will result in expulsion.
6. Hitting, kicking, pushing, and other forms of physical violence and aggression are not permitted and will not be tolerated.
7. Students are expected to accept responsibility for their behavior and accept the consequences for misbehavior.
8. Students are expected to respond with grace and humility when there is a need for correction in dress or behavior. Of course, patience and mutual respect on the part of faculty is also expected.

Depending on the situation, **temporary or permanent removal** from the school may be required.

Discipline:

Logical and natural consequences will be used. Because we stress ownership of the program by the students, we will often hold a student "court" to help determine what the consequences will be for an offense. This teaches the students mercy while helping them see the impact that their inappropriate behavior may have had on the community. Compass Prep always strives to work closely with parents in an effort to remedy any discipline issues while encouraging parents to find and implement the best plan for their family.
